Queen Elizabeth II, UK's head of state, confirmed Theresa May as the new PM.

Theresa May has appointed Boris Johnson, the former London mayor who led the Brexit campaign, foreign secretary in her new government.

Earlier, outside 10 Downing Street, after returning from Buckingham Palace where she was formally appointed prime minister by the Queen, Mrs May paid tribute to her predecessor David Cameron, who resigned after losing the EU Brexit referendum of June 2016. After his resignation, Mrs May was elected by the Conservative Party to succeed him.

DOC.2 Under the 2011 Fixed Term Parliaments Act, a general election is supposed to take place every five years on the first Thursday in May. As the most recent general election was in 2015, the next one was scheduled for May 2020.

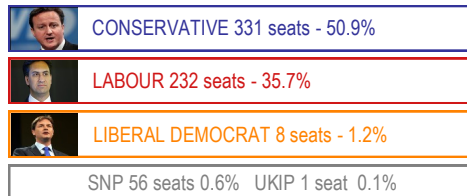
But an election can be called ahead of schedule for two reasons - if there is a vote of no confidence in the current government or if MPs vote for an early election by a two-thirds majority.

Theresa May chose the second option, which was passed by Westminster by 522 votes to 13, because the end of the Brexit negotiations is set for March 2019, when political parties would be starting to campaign for the 2020 general election.

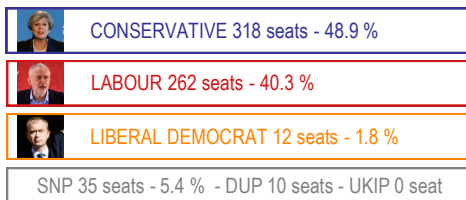
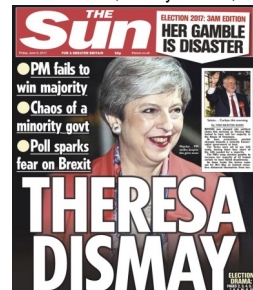
Share of the 650 MP seats in the House of Commons

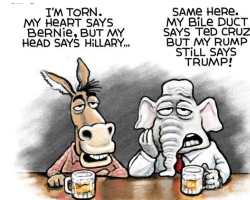

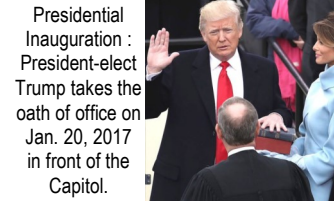

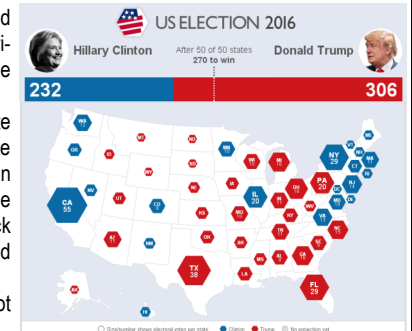

DOC.7 And so in the pages of American history, a new and astonishing chapter has been written. A man with no experience of government and who's never held elected office, is the next US head of state.

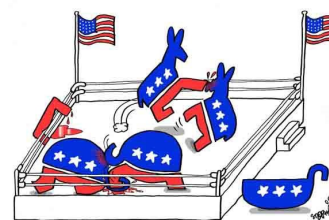

• The 2008 US historic presidential election

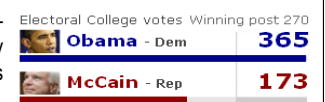


The presidential nomination, Stephen Peray, February 6, 2008.
